DAY 01: ARRIVE IN KEFLAVIK/KEFLAVIK - REYKJAVIK

Arrive in Keflavik. You will be transferred by Flybus shuttle bus from Keflavik Airport to your hotel in Reykjavík where you will spend the night. You will be provided with ideas how to explore Iceland's capital on your own.

Overnight in Reykjavik.

DAY 02: VOLCANO CRATER, SEALS, FJORDS AND MOUNTAINS

After breakfast, at 0900 hrs, meet your tour guide and depart from your hotel. You will travel west, passing the town of **Borgarnes** and will climb the **Grabrok volcano crater**. In the afternoon, you will visit a natural history and seal museum in a small fishing village in Northwest Iceland and stroll around the local harbour. Further north, you will stop at the



turf church of **Vidimyri** which has been extensively restored to its original form and is widely considered one of the purest and most beautiful examples of traditional Icelandic architecture. You will continue along scenic fjord landscape and over several mountain passes until you reach Akureyri - the capital of North Iceland. (B)

Overnight in Akureyri.

DAY 03: THE CAPITAL OF NORTH ICELAND, LAKE MYVATN AND GEOTHERMAL BATHS

After breakfast, in the morning, you will explore Akureyri, a charming town of 17000 inhabitants, visit the botanical garden and enjoy the panoramic view over **Eyjafjordur** fjord. In the afternoon, you will travel to an important spot in Iceland's history, **Godafoss** - the waterfalls of the Gods. You will continue to Lake Myvatn which is known for its geological wonders and active bird life during



summer. You will stop at the bizarre lava formations at **Kalfastrond** followed by a walk around the many pseudo craters and end an exciting day with a relaxing soak at **Myvatn Nature Baths** that contains a unique blend of minerals, silicates and geothermal micro-organisms. The warm soothing waters benefit both skin and spirit alike. (B)

Overnight in Lake Myvatn.

DAY 04: LAVA LABYRINTH, HOT SPRINGS AND TRAVEL EAST

After breakfast, in the morning, you will hike in a lava labyrinth at **Dimmuborgir** "the dark castles", hoping to get a glimpse of the trolls who are said to live there. After an **Optional** lunch, you will visit the hot spring area of **Namaskard** with bubbling mud pools and steaming solfataras. You will head through the uninhabited highlands and moonlike surrounding to East Iceland. With some luck, you might spot an



Arctic fox or see reindeer. From June to August the tour includes a detour to Dettifoss. (B)

Overnight in Herad.

DAY 05: FJORDS, GLACIER AND ICE

After breakfast, a day to admire the dramatic fjord landscape and its tiny fishing villages at the end of twisty roads in the East Fjords and on route, you will visit an interesting stone and mineral collection. In the afternoon, you will see **Vatnajokull** – Europe's biggest glacier that is visible all over Southeast Iceland. Past the town of Hofn, you will stop at **Jokulsarlon**, a glacial lagoon filled with floating



icebergs, and you will explore the extraordinary site and might see seals swimming in arctic waters. You can walk on the black sandy beach where large icebergs get stranded. Depending on the season, **Optional** boat trips are available. You will travel along the southern part of the glacier Vatnajokull and spend time at Europe's largest national park, which has Iceland's highest mountains, an alpine environment, and Europe's largest glacier. (B)

Overnight in Kirkjubaejarklaustur.

DAY 06: SOUTH COAST

After breakfast, a beautiful drive with many natural wonders awaits you as you will head across the **Eldhraun** lava field, cross the sandy desert of the south coast, overlooked by mountainous cliffs, glaciers and waterfalls. You will stroll along the black lava beach of **Reynisfjara** near Vik. In the small village of Skogar, there is **Skogafoss** waterfall which is 60 meters high and is one of the most impressive waterfalls in the country. Further west, you will stop



at the **Eyjafjallajokull Information Center** and learn about living next to a glacier and an active volcano. You will continue to the high, but narrow **Seljalandsfoss** waterfall which plunges over the mountain. There is an interesting trail that goes behind the fall – if you are prepared to get wet. (B)

Overnight in Fludir.

DAY 07: ICELANDIC HORSES AND GOLDEN CIRCLE

After breakfast, you will explore classics as you will travel the route of the Golden Circle sights. You will start the day at **Fridheimar**, where you will learn about the Icelandic horse, its special qualities and history and visit a geothermal greenhouse. Later on, you will see steam from the **Geysir** geothermal fields as you arrive. There is a variety of hot springs and bubbling pools. The original geyser is now dormant but has been replaced by **Strokkur** "the Churn" which



erupts at 5 to 10 minute intervals. You will continue to **Gullfoss**, "the golden falls", which is a double waterfall that tumbles 34 meters into the Hvita River and attracts travellers in summer and winter. You will travel inland to **Thingvellir National Park** - a UNESCO World Heritage site. As you will return to Reykjavik, you will be taken for a short city tour to show highlights of the world's northernmost capital. (B)

Overnight in Reykjavik.

DAY 08: DEPARTURE DAY

After breakfast, you will be transferred by Flybus airport shuttle to Keflavík Airport. (B)
