Iceland Circle Tour with Whale Watching (Saturday)

8 Nights / 9 Days

1N Reykjavik / 1N Reykholt / 2N Husavik / 1N Hallormsstadur / 1N Skaftafell / 1N Hveragerdi / 1N Reykjavik

DAY 01: ARRIVE IN KEFLAVIK/KEFLAVIK - REYKJAVIK

Arrive in Keflavik. Upon arrival, the Flybus shuttle will transfer you from Keflavík International airport to Reykjavík where you will spend the first night in Iceland. You will be provided with ideas how to explore Iceland's capital on your own.

Overnight in Reykjavik.

DAY 02: LAND OF SAGAS

After breakfast, do a Reykjavik city tour. After the tour, head north from Iceland's capital to West Iceland where you will be introduced to the Icelandic sagas in the settlement center in **Borgarnes**. The afternoon is filled with impressive natural spots: **Deildartunguhver**, one of the most voluminous hot springs in Europe and **Hraunfossar**, the unique waterfall that drains from under vast lava fields into the river Hvita. End the day with Icelandic history at the cultural site at **Reykholt**. (BD)

DAY 03: FROM WEST TO NORTH

After breakfast, the day starts with climbing a volcano crater in an old lava field in West Iceland. Afterwards, you will travel through the fertile farmlands and fjord landscapes of Northwest Iceland, and visit the beautiful town of Akureyri, Iceland's second largest city. You will stop at **Godafoss**, "the waterfall of the Gods," before reaching your hotel in Northeast Iceland where you will stay for the next two nights. (BD)

DAY 04: WHALE WATCHING, GEOLOGICAL WONDERS AND NATURE BATHS

After breakfast, the day begins with a 3 hour **whale watching cruise** from Husavik (weather permitting). You will tour the **Lake Myvatn area**, considered as one of the most fertile areas in the world so close to the Arctic Circle. The lake's unique features are shaped by nature - strange lava formations, pseudo craters, attractive bays filled with thousands of birds. You will stroll through the lava field of **Dimmuborgir** and soak at the **Myvatn Nature Baths**. (BD)

DAY 05: FROM NORTH TO EAST

After breakfast, you start the day by exploring the geothermal area of **Namaskard** and seeing the impacts of volcanic activity at **Krafla**. Then, you will travel to **Dettifoss**, Europe's most powerful waterfall in the northern part of **Vatnajokull National Park**. From there you will head through the uninhabited highlands to East Iceland, where you will spend the night. (BD)

DAY 06: FJORDS, GLACIER AND ICE

After breakfast, enjoy the day to admire the dramatic fjord landscape and its tiny fishing villages at the end of twisty roads in the East Fjords. Soon, you will see **Vatnajokull** - Europe's biggest glacier that is visible all over Southeast Iceland. Past the town of Hofn, you will stop for a boat ride among the floating icebergs on the glacial lagoon at **Jokulsarlon**. The night is spent near **Skaftafell** on the southern part of Vatnajokull National Park. (BD)

DAY 07: VATNAJOKULL NATIONAL PARK AND THE SOUTH

After breakfast, visit Skaftafell at Vatnajokull National Park, nestled below the glacier and Iceland's highest mountain, the 2110 meter high **Hvannadalshnjukur**. You will cross the sandy desert of the south coast, and travel along mountainous cliffs, glaciers and waterfalls. You will stroll along the black lava beach and bird cliffs near the village of Vik. Iceland's past comes alive at the **Skogar folk museum** with its turf houses. (BD)

DAY 08: RING THE GOLDEN CIRCLE TO REYKJAVIK

After breakfast, you will start with a horse show that introduces the unique qualities of Iceland's special breed. Golden Circle sights follow: **Gullfoss**, the beautiful double "Golden Falls"; the active geothermal area of **Geysir**, where you can see **Strokkur** "the churn" spout up to 25 meters (70 feet) every five to seven minutes. A visit to the ancient Viking Parliament area of **Thingvellir National Park** tops it off before returning to Reykjavík. (B)

DAY 09: DEPARTURE DAY

After breakfast, the Flybus airport shuttle will pick you up at your hotel and you will be transferred to Keflavik airport. (B)

- 6) You spend about 4 hours per day on the bus, depending on road conditions, traffic and daily distances. On some days the driving might be longer than on some other days.
- 7) Supplement for guaranteed window seat on escorted coach tours which includes a window seat and next seat remaining empty (a passenger gets actually two seats) as well as a pillow and blanket for upgraded comfort. Seats will be reserved in the front rows of the bus, first comes, first get.
- 8) Once a booking is confirmed, the departure is guaranteed.
- 9) Tour starts on Sundays at 0900 hrs from Reykjavik. The tour ends on Saturdays in Reykjavík between 1600 1800 hrs.
